Reports to: Community Engagement Coordinator

Hours: 4 hours a week

Responsibilities

- Attend offsite community events to represent the AIDS network at a booth or table
- Distribute flyers and pamphlets, provide information on the organization's services and upcoming events, HIV/AIDS, and harm reduction
- Work with the education team (WHAI, MSM, ACB) to disseminate information to the public
- Attend bathhouses to distribute harm reduction supplies and information
- Other duties specified by supervisor and other staff

Qualifications

- Experience in a similar position and knowledge on The AIDS Network, HIV/AIDS, and harm reduction preferred, but not required as training will be provided
- Share with the organization its mission, vision, and values
- Must be approachable, friendly, and possess strong communication skills
- Comfortable working with people from various marginalized backgrounds
- Valid Ontario driver's licence and access to a vehicle preferred
