Men4Men aims to enhance the lives of gay, bisexual, queer and other men who have sex with men by reinforcing self-esteem and personal empowerment through sexual health education and resources. The Outreach Volunteers' job is to represent the Men4Men program in the community and distribute safer sex kits, information, and resources.

Hours: 4 hours a week

Responsibilities

- Attend offsite community events to represent Men4Men at a booth or table
- Assemble safer sex kits
- Provide information on the Men4Men clinic and distribute safer sex kits at bathhouses, college and university campuses, public health clinics, campgrounds, bars and clubs
- Online outreach GRINDR, Scruff, and Squirt.com
- Other duties specified by supervisor and other staff

Qualifications

- Experience in a similar position and knowledge on Men4Men and gay men's sexual health (GMSH) preferred, but not required as training will be provided
- Share with the organization its mission, vision, and values
- Ability to operate from an intersectional, anti-oppressive and sex positive framework
- Must be approachable, friendly, and possess strong communication skills
- Comfortable working with people from various marginalized backgrounds
- Valid Ontario driver's licence and access to a vehicle preferred
