- Volunteers for and willingly accepts assignments and completes them thoroughly and on time
- Stays informed about Board of Director/committee matters, prepares themselves well for meetings and reviews and comments on minutes and reports
- Gets to know other committee members and builds a collegial working relationship that contributes to consensus
- Is an active participant in the committee's annual evaluation and planning efforts?
- Participates in fundraising for the organization
- Mentors new Directors
